

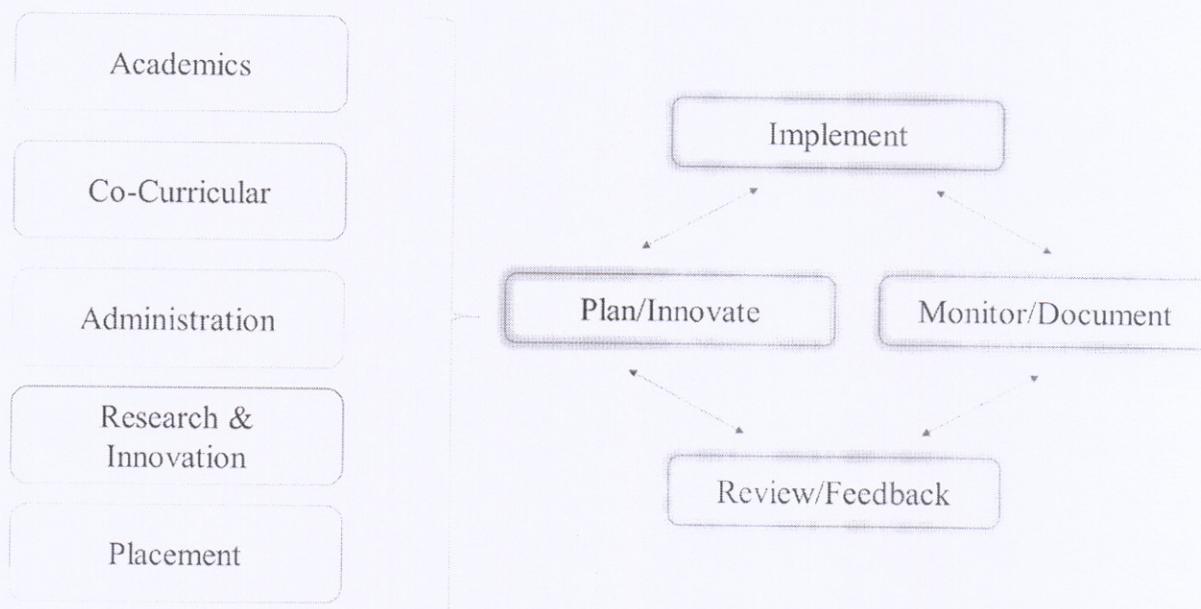


Fig:1 - IQAC Functional chart
